## IICIR Story

The International Intensive Course for Interventional Radiology [IICIR] has been held every year since 2002 in Seoul, Korea. This intensive educational course has provided practical education in the form of basic lectures, hands-on workshops, and animal studies. The IICIR was established at the initiative of professor Jae Hyung Park at the Seoul National University hospital. Since the year 2011, the program was officially embraced and organized by KSIR. Since its birth, more than 720 trainees have participated in IICIR until 2019. The purpose of IICIR is to share our knowledge and experience with young interventional radiologists. This meeting is also intended to provide an opportunity for young interventional radiologists to socialize and exchange their experiences and ultimately develop new friendships.

## About KSIR

(Korean Society of Interventional Radiology)

KSIR now consists of 300 members working at 76 hospitals. It has 5 regional groups: Seoul-Gyeonggi [Seoul area]; Choongchung [Central]; Honam [South-west]; Youngnam [South-east]; and West Gyeongin. Each regional group holds monthly conferences where members actively discuss IR cases. The KSIR holds its two day annual meeting every spring and a morbidity & mortality conference at the end of every year. Furthermore, Image guided endovascular treatment(IGET) live symposium and endovascular school are held every year for junior members.


